BOARD OF GOVERNORS

The Board of Governors serves as the executive body of the University, entrusted with the governance and management of its affairs in accordance with the University Act and Statutes. It holds the responsibility of supervising the University's administration, funds, and property while ensuring proper financial governance by managing budgets, accounts, and investments with advice from the Finance and Planning Committee. The Board oversees the acquisition, transfer, and upkeep of assets, develops essential infrastructure, and ensures the provision of facilities such as libraries, buildings, and accommodations.

It plays a pivotal role in academic oversight by establishing teaching and research positions, affiliating institutions, and recommend conferring of honorary degrees. Additionally, the Board is responsible for appointing staff, prescribing their duties, and handling disciplinary matters. It proposes statutes, reviews regulations and, delegates powers to committees or individuals, and performs other functions as mandated by the Act, making it integral to the University's growth, academic excellence, and administrative efficiency.



ACADEMIC COUNCIL

The Academic Council is the highest academic authority at the University, delegated with overseeing and maintaining standards in instruction, scholarship, research, and examinations. It has the authority to advise the Board on academic matters, regulate the admission of students to courses and examinations, and propose the creation and organization of Faculties, Teaching Departments, Institutes, and Boards of Studies. The Council is also responsible for planning and developing teaching and research initiatives within the University. Additionally, it has the power to make regulations on course content and syllabi for all University examinations, based on recommendations from the Board of Faculties and Boards of Studies. If such recommendations are delayed, the Council may continue the existing courses with Board approval. The Council can recognize examinations from other universities or examining bodies as equivalent to the University's own. It is also authorized to frame regulations for submission to the Board and to perform other functions as outlined by the statutes


FIRST MEETING OF ACADEMIC COUNCIL (FALL 2024-2025)

RULES, REGULATIONS & CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS

1. PURPOSE

This document serves as an official acknowledgment that every student of Al-Kawthar University understands, accepts, and agrees to comply with the university's Rules, Regulations, and Code of Conduct. These regulations are designed to maintain discipline, mutual respect, academic integrity, and a safe learning environment for all.

2. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

a. Respect for University Authority

Students must comply with all lawful instructions issued by university officials, faculty members, and administrative staff. Respect toward institutional hierarchy and adherence to policies are mandatory.

b. Academic Integrity

Students are expected to uphold honesty and integrity in all academic work. Acts of cheating, plagiarism, falsification of records, or unauthorized collaboration are strictly prohibited.

c. Attendance and Punctuality

Students are required to attend all scheduled classes, laboratories, and official university activities punctually. Absences must be supported with valid documentation and approved by the concerned authority.

d. Dress Code

Students must dress modestly, neatly, and appropriately as per university guidelines. Clothing that is offensive, indecent, or disruptive to the academic environment is not permitted.

e. Behavior and Discipline

Students must treat faculty, staff, and peers with courtesy and respect. The use of abusive, discriminatory, or offensive language or behavior is prohibited. Any form of harassment, bullying, or violence will result in disciplinary action.

f. Care for University Property

Students must respect all University property, facilities, and resources. Acts of vandalism, littering, or misuse of property are strictly forbidden and will result in penalties.

g. Prohibited Activities

The following are strictly prohibited on or off campus:

- (i).** Possession, use, or distribution of drugs, alcohol, or weapons.
- (ii).** Involvement in political, religious, or social activities that disrupt University harmony.
- (iii).** Engaging in cyberbullying, hacking, or spreading false or misleading information

h. Responsible Use of Technology

University computer systems, networks, and internet services must be used ethically. Accessing or sharing inappropriate, illegal, or harmful online content is strictly prohibited.

i. Examination Conduct

Students must follow all examination procedures and instructions. The use of mobile phones, notes, or unauthorized materials during examinations constitutes academic misconduct.

j. Media Recording & Social Media Use

Unauthorized photography, video- graphy, or audio recording within university premises is prohibited. Students must not upload or share any image, video, logo, or content related to Al-Kawthar University on social or digital media in any misleading, controversial, or inappropriate context. Violations will result in disciplinary or legal consequences.

k. Unauthorized Photography or Videography

No student may record or photograph another person on campus without explicit consent. Violation of this rule authorizes the University to take appropriate disciplinary or legal action.

l. Drugs and Illegal Activities

Any involvement in drug use, possession, or illegal activities on or off campus is strictly forbidden. Such behavior will result in immediate disciplinary action, which may include suspension or expulsion.

m. Confidentiality and Privacy

Students must not share, transmit, or disclose any confidential university data, records, or documents without written authorization. Breach of confidentiality is a serious offense and could result in disciplinary or legal consequences.

n. Harassment, Respect and Student Privacy

Students must respect the dignity, privacy, and personal space of all individuals. Harassment, inappropriate conduct, or unwanted interaction especially toward members of the opposite gender, is strictly prohibited. Sharing another student's personal details without consent is a serious disciplinary violation.

3. ADDITIONAL UNIVERSITY RULES

a. Anti-Discrimination & Inclusivity

Students must not discriminate against any individual based on religion, ethnicity, gender, disability, or socioeconomic background. The University fosters a culture of equality, tolerance, and inclusion.

b. Student Identification (ID Card Policy)

Students must carry their official University ID card at all times while on campus and present it when requested by authorized personnel. Misuse, lending, or duplication of ID cards is strictly prohibited.

c. Library and Laboratory Ethics

Students must use all library and laboratory materials responsibly. Damaging, removing, or mishandling University property may result in fines or replacement costs.

d. Financial Obligations

Students must meet all financial responsibilities, including tuition fees, fines, and dues, within the specified deadlines. Failure to comply may result in suspension of academic privileges or withholding of transcripts and certificates.

e. Student Representation and Grievance Redressal

g. Disciplinary Procedure

Violations of these Rules and the Code of Conduct will be reviewed by the University Disciplinary Committee, which may impose sanctions including warnings, probation, suspension, or expulsion.

h. Health, Safety, and Emergency Compliance

Students must comply with all University health and safety protocols and cooperate during emergencies, drills, or medical alerts. Behavior that endangers personal or community safety will not be tolerated.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- **For most Undergraduate Programs:** Minimum 45% marks in Intermediate (HSSC) or equivalent
- **For BS Nursing:** FSc Pre-Medical with at least 50% marks in intermediate, in line with Pakistan Nursing Council (PNC) requirements
- Additional eligibility for specific programs may apply (see relevant departments)
- Must appear in Al-Kawthar University Placement Test (UPT) and interview

GUIDELINES FOR OVERSEAS STUDENTS

NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE (NOC) FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS

Foreign students applying to Al-Kawthar University are required to obtain a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the Higher Education Commission (HEC) Pakistan for admission and student visa processing. This is done in coordination with the Ministry of Interior.

TRANSFER & MIGRATION POLICY

- Transfer applications are accepted from HEC-recognized institutions
- Students provide:
 - Academic Transcripts
 - Course Outlines/Syllabus
 - NOC from Previous University
- Transfers subject to departmental review and seat availability
- Students must have a minimum CGPA of 2.00/4.00
- Migration is not allowed in the final year or semester

1. ADMISSION PROCESS

All applications for admissions shall be received through the Online Public Portal of the University (eportal.alkawthar.edu.pk). Candidates shall upload the required documents in electronic format as prescribed in the Portal.

2. ADMISSION ELIGIBILITY

A candidate must possess the relevant qualification required for eligibility in order to be considered for admission into a program. Those having non-HSSC or non-DAE qualifications must provide equivalence for these from IBCC. Admission Eligibility requirements for different undergraduate degree programs are provided in Table found at the end of this document.

3. CONDITIONAL ADMISSION ON BASIS OF HSSC PART 1 RESULT

Candidates who have cleared Part-I of the required eligibility qualification (e.g. HSSC) for a degree program and are awaiting result of the Part-II shall be considered for Conditional Admission into the program. Conditional Admission, if granted, shall be canceled automatically if the candidate fails to clear Part-II upon announcement of the result. No fee shall be refunded to such candidates whose Conditional Admission is canceled. Other matters related to such cases shall be handled as per relevant University Rules and Policies.

4. ADMISSION TEST

In general, candidates must appear in Al-Kawthar University Admission Test prescribed for the program. However, the University may offer admission based on Admission Test, or at its discretion, waive the requirement of Admission Test, keeping in view the difficulty of coming to Karachi for admission test for out-of-city candidates as well as the prevailing emergency weather conditions during rainy seasons for all candidates.

Al-Kawthar University Admission Test shall be conducted through an Online System. Candidates may register for Admission Test through the Admissions Portal and must pay the prescribed Admission Test Fee. Al-Kawthar University may, at its discretion, accept the result of any other standardized test as equivalent to its own admission test.

5. ADMISSION MERIT CALCULATION

In case of admission granted on the basis of Admission Test and past academic record, Merit for Admission may be calculated based on the following formula:

$$\text{ADMISSION MERIT} = 0.4 \times \text{HSSC Percentage} + 0.6 \times \text{Admission Test Score}$$

In case of admission granted solely based on HSSC or equivalent examination, Admission Merit may be calculated based on the following formula:

$$\text{ADMISSION MERIT} = 1.0 \times \text{HSSC Percentage}$$

6. ADMISSION INTERVIEW

An Admission Interview may be conducted where prescribed/deemed necessary by the University. Admission will only be granted to candidates who pass the Admission Interview, where such interview is prescribed. Admission Interview shall be conducted on PASS / FAIL basis and shall not contribute to numerical determination of Admission Merit.

7. ADMISSION MERIT CUTOFF

Al-Kawthar University shall prescribe, and may revise periodically, the Admission Merit Cutoff on both, per Degree Program basis and per Admission Cohort basis, for each Cohort to be offered admission. Following Cohorts shall be applicable to Fall 2025 Admissions:

First Cohort:	December 2025
Second Cohort:	January 2026
Third Cohort:	February 2026

Admission Merit Cutoff for different undergraduate degree programs for the First Cohort are provided in Table. Admission Merit Cutoff may be revised for each subsequent Cohort.

Candidates not offered admission in earlier cohorts shall be considered on Waiting List and may improve their merit through additional Admission Tests or be offered admission if cutoff is revised lower, subject to availability of seats.

8. ADMISSION OFFER LETTER

Eligible candidates meeting the Admission Merit Cutoff shall be issued Admission Offer Letter specifying Terms & Conditions. All admissions shall be initially offered on Provisional Basis and confirmed only after verification of documents and fulfillment of formalities.

Conditional Admission candidates must fulfill additional conditions mentioned in

the Offer Letter within the specified time, failing which admission shall be canceled automatically.

9. FEE PAYMENT

Candidates must pay the associated Fee Voucher within the specified time, otherwise the Admission Offer shall be canceled automatically.

10. FEE PAYMENT IN INSTALLMENTS

Students desirous of paying fee in installments may pay in two or three equal installments as per approved policy through the Office of Student Support Services.

11. REGISTRATION OF ADMITTED CANDIDATES AS AL-KAWTHAR UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

After fee payment, students shall be registered and allotted Registration Numbers. Registration includes:

- a. **Document Inspection:** Student must bring original documents for physical inspection by University officials at the time of Registration. Submitted academic documents will be subsequently verified through the relevant educational boards which is a necessary condition of admission to the University.
- b. **Submission of Undertaking:** The prescribed undertaking form must be duly signed by the student and his / her parent / guardian and submitted at the time of Registration.
- c. **Medical Certificate:** Student must get the required Medical Tests performed at Modern Hospital and submit the Medical Certificate duly attested by Medical Officer at Modern Hospital. University may facilitate candidates by engaging Modern Hospital staff at the time of Registration.
- d. **Photograph:** Two recent passport-size photographs (2" x 2") with a white background.
- e. **Completion of Student Digital Profile**

12. MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS & NEED BASED FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR NEW ADMISSIONS

Need Based Financial Assistance. Students applying for Need Based Financial Assistance may be allowed to pay Fee in three equal installments with First Installment to be paid within due date, subject to preliminary scrutiny of their application by the Office of Scholarships & Financial Assistance.

Amount of Need Based Financial Assistance Award and remaining fee payment due shall be finalized after thorough process of scrutiny of all applications and conduct of interviews by the designated University Committee. This process shall be completed by the end of the sixth week of the semester.

Merit Scholarship (Based on Admission Test):

Merit Scholarships for the first semester shall be finalized and awarded on per program basis after the Midterm Exams of the semester. Office of Scholarships & Financial Assistance may be contacted for further information on the subject.



1. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE (NEED-BASED FINANCIAL SUPPORT) OR QARZ-E-HASANA

Al-Kawthar University shall provide Need Based Financial Assistance as a Qarz-e-Hasana to students from low-income families. Awardees shall have a moral obligation to repay after completing education, thereby helping future needy students.

Eligibility:

Complete Financial Profile of student's family shall be required as per Al-Kawthar University Need Based Financial Assistance Application Form.

Application:

Submit the Financial Assistance Form.

Processing Time:

Minimum Six Weeks including interview & verification.

Confidentiality:

2. SCHOLARSHIPS (MERIT-BASED)

A. First Semester: Based on Admission Test Score

University may announce Merit Based Fee Waivers on Tuition Fee as part of its efforts for encouraging meritorious students to apply for admission. Terms and conditions for such schemes shall be announced by the Admissions Office and may be revised from time to time by the University.

B. First Semester: Based on Result of Intermediate Boards / CIE / IB or Equivalent

90% Fee Waiver on Tuition Fee shall be granted to top 3 positions in Intermediate Boards OR 4 A's in A-levels or IB equivalent.


C. After First Semester: Based on Semester GPA

In semesters after the first semester, Merit Scholarship amount given to an individual student, among the top 5% of the students in each degree program, will depend on the performance of the respective student in the previous semester examination according to the SGPA obtained by the student.


The Merit Scholarship amount awarded to an eligible student will be 90% of semester tuition fee if his/her SGPA is 4.0 and 0% if his/her SGPA is 3.0 (or lower). For SGPA values between 3.0 and 4.0, the merit scholarship amount will be linearly prorated between 0% and 90% of student's semester tuition fee.

Example: A student who is among top 5% of students and thus is eligible for the Merit Scholarship and his/her SGPA is 3.50 will get 45% of tuition fee as Merit Scholarship amount. In case his/her SGPA is 3.60, he/she will get 54% of tuition fee as Merit Scholarship amount.

- a) To promote dissemination of research findings through conferences, journals, exhibitions, and community outreach.


